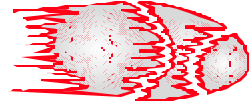


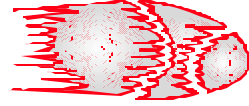
Woodbury Wildpitch



Rules

1. This tournament is ASA sanctioned. All participating teams must be ASA or ASA USA -MSF (Minnesota Sports Federation) members and provide membership verification at time of registration (i.e. ASA 2006 Membership Card).
2. This tournament offers berths to the AFA national championship tournaments: to the two highest placing teams in the Gold (A) and Silver (B) brackets. "A" bracket qualifiers will be offered berths to the AFA "A" nationals and "B" bracket qualifiers will be offered berths to the AFA "B" nationals.
3. All teams must check in with completed rosters, ASA verification, AFA verification if applicable, and two Dudley COR.47 optic yellow balls (or equivalent) at least 30 minutes prior to your first game time. There will be a check in table near the concession stands at both Ojibway Park and the Bielenberg Sport Complex.
4. Except where modified by these rules, ASA USA rules govern play.
5. Protests on the interpretation of game rules shall be decided on the playing field and must be made before the next pitch is thrown. The decision of the umpire is final.
6. Home team shall be determined by coin toss.
7. Batting of the entire roster and unlimited substitution is mandatory. A courtesy runner is optional for the pitcher and catcher. The runner shall be the player that made the last out.
8. Games will be seven innings in length with time limits, except for 10U division (5 innings). No new inning may begin after 1 hour and 10 minutes of play, except for championship games on Sunday, which have no time limit. International tie-breaker rule applies for extra inning championship games.
9. Ties will be broken using the international rule after time expires in Medal play and while time permits in pool play. Pool play games may end in a tie.
10. There will be a 15-run rule after 3 innings, and 8 run rule after 5 innings. In the 10U division, teams may score a maximum of 5 runs per ½ inning. Run rules are NOT waived for championship games for 12U and 14U. Run rules remain in effect for 10U.
11. The criteria for placement of teams into the championship brackets (medal play) in order of priority are: Won/Loss Record, Head to Head Competition, Runs Allowed, Runs Scored, Coin Toss.

Other Information

- ✓ In the event of inclement weather, the tournament director reserves the right to adjust the number of games, game length, and schedule to meet conditions.
- ✓ ASA rules require that chin straps and face masks be worn by all players at all age levels.
- ✓ Bracket Boards at the fields are considered official. Coaches are required to check the boards in the event of changes. It is the responsibility of the winning coach to collect the blue score card from the umpire and deliver it to the concession stand so the Bracket Boards may be updated.
- ✓ **No soft-toss batting against the fence is allowed at Woodbury fields.**
- ✓ All dugouts will have tarps.
- ✓ Concessions and softball merchandise will be available during the tournament; however concessions will be limited to the Bielenberg Sports Complex for Friday night play.
